Meeting called to order at 4:04p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

Nate Reinhold talked to the senate about why he would be a good justice.

He said that when in New Business, to approve Nate Reinhold, pending that he meets eligibility requirements. The SGA needed to allocate money for the purchasing of the awards pieces. He recommended approving up to \$65/75 for each plaque, to come from the bursars account. He recommended the senate approve up to \$250 for the Mike Wargo plaque.

Jessica motioned to send the SGA Constitution back to committee. Ngaatendwe 2nd.
Motion passed unanimously of those present.

Ngaatendwe motioned to discuss the Sigma Pi Sigma request. Teresa S. 2nd.

Ngaatendwe and Teresa expressed their concerns about the request.

Mphatso motioned to table. Kristina 2nd.
Motion passed unanimously of those present.

Kristina motioned to move to the good of the order.
