MINOR in ECONOMICS



Students pursuing a four-year degree in non-business programs may combine formal study in Economics with their stated major by concurrently completing a minor in Economics. Students who elect this program must notify their advisor and the School of Business and Economics advisor before the end of their junior year.

Requirements (15 credit hours):

- ♦ ECON-E103 Introduction to Microeconomics
(or S103) Introduction to Microeconomics-Honors
- ♦ ECON-E104 Introduction to Macroeconomics
(or S104) Introduction to Macroeconomics-Honors
- ♦ ECON-E321 Intermediate Microeconomic Theory
- ♦ ECON-E322 Intermediate Macroeconomic Theory
- ♦ One additional economics course at the 300 or 400 level

Students must attain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (C) in all five of the courses taken for the minor and not less than a C grade in each course. Please note that these courses may not be taken by correspondence study or independent study; they also may not be studied through an internship.
