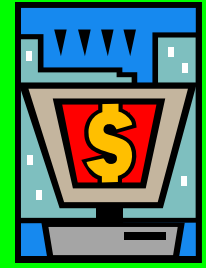


ANNOUNCING OUTSIDE MINOR in FINANCE for Non-Business Majors



Students who are pursuing a four-year degree in non-business programs may combine formal study in Finance with their stated major by concurrently completing an Outside Minor in Finance. Students who elect this program must notify their advisor and the School of Business and Economics advisor before the end of their junior year.

Requirements (30 credit hours)

Required Prerequisite Courses:

- ♦ BUS-A201 Introduction to Financial Accounting
- ♦ BUS-K201 The Computer in Business or any Computer Course
- ♦ ECON-E104 Introduction to Macroeconomics
- ♦ ECON-E270 Introduction to Statistical Theory in Economics and Business or any Statistics Course
- ♦ MATH-M118 Finite Mathematics

Required Finance Courses:

- ♦ BUS-F260 Personal Finance
- ♦ BUS-F301 Financial Management
- ♦ BUS-F302 Financial Decision Making
- ♦ BUS-F345 Money, Banking, and Capital Markets
- ♦ BUS-F420 Investment

For non-business majors, the BUS-F301 course requires prerequisites of BUS-A201, ECON-E104, and ECON-E270 or any statistics course. The BUS-F301 course is a prerequisite for BUS-F302, BUS-F345 and BUS-F420.

Students must attain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (C) in all the above 10 courses and not less than a C grade in each course. These courses cannot be taken by correspondence study or by independent study; they also may not be studied through an internship.
