Graduate Checkpoint #2: (End of P503 in order to continue in the program)

- **GPA Verification**
 - Completed by Student Services Office.
- **Minimum of 12 graduate credits with at least 6 from the basic requirements list**
 - Completed by Student Services Office.
- **H520 Philosophy of Education**
 - Students will attach their Philosophy of Education statement or link to the LiveText document.
- **P503 Research Proposal**
 - Students will attach their Research Proposal, with IRB paperwork, ready for submission or link to the LiveText document
