**Summer II 2005 Enrollment Highlights**

- ⇒ Overall, all campuses of Indiana University were down 10,914.5 student credit hours, or 9.8 percent, in the second summer session of 2005.
- ⇒ Non-resident population at IU South Bend was up on the strong growth in international students. Fifteen more international students attended the second summer session compared to last year, an increase of 13.6 percent.

Note: Some changes in data management has shifted many students to a non-degree status during the summer terms. The change will make it difficult to make some historical comparisons.

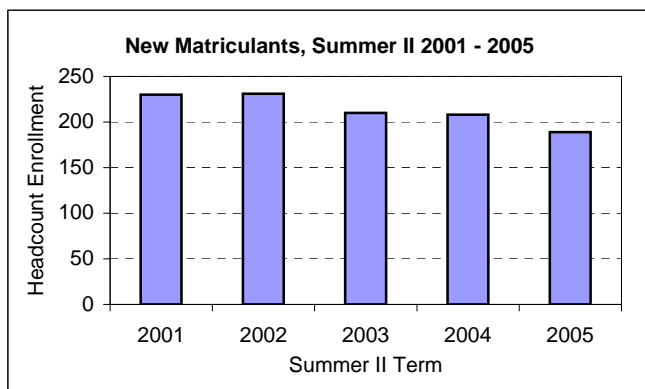
