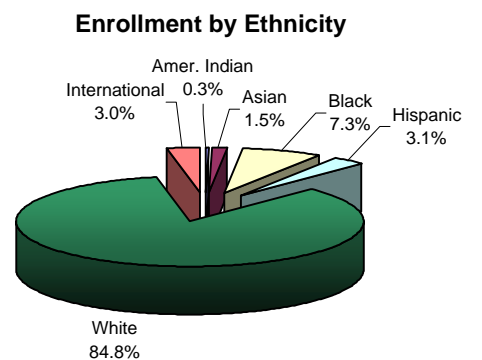
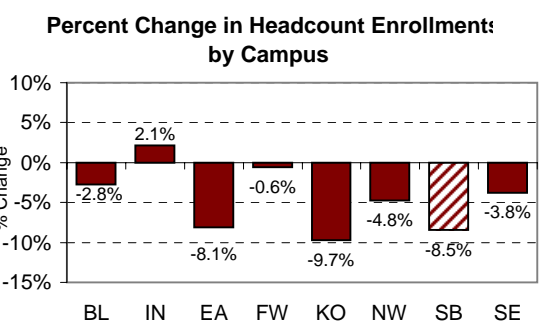

Summer I 2006 Enrollment Highlights

- ⇒ Continued statewide 3-year trend of declining summer enrollments. Overall, Indiana University headcount enrollment is down 1.8 percent compared to last year.
- ⇒ IU South Bend continues to experience an increase in the number of Hispanic enrollments with an 11 percent increase compared to last first summer session.
- ⇒ The largest declines in summer enrollments have been among our juniors, seniors, and graduate students.

Note: Some changes in data management has shifted many students to a non-degree status during the summer terms. The change will make it difficult to make some historical comparisons.

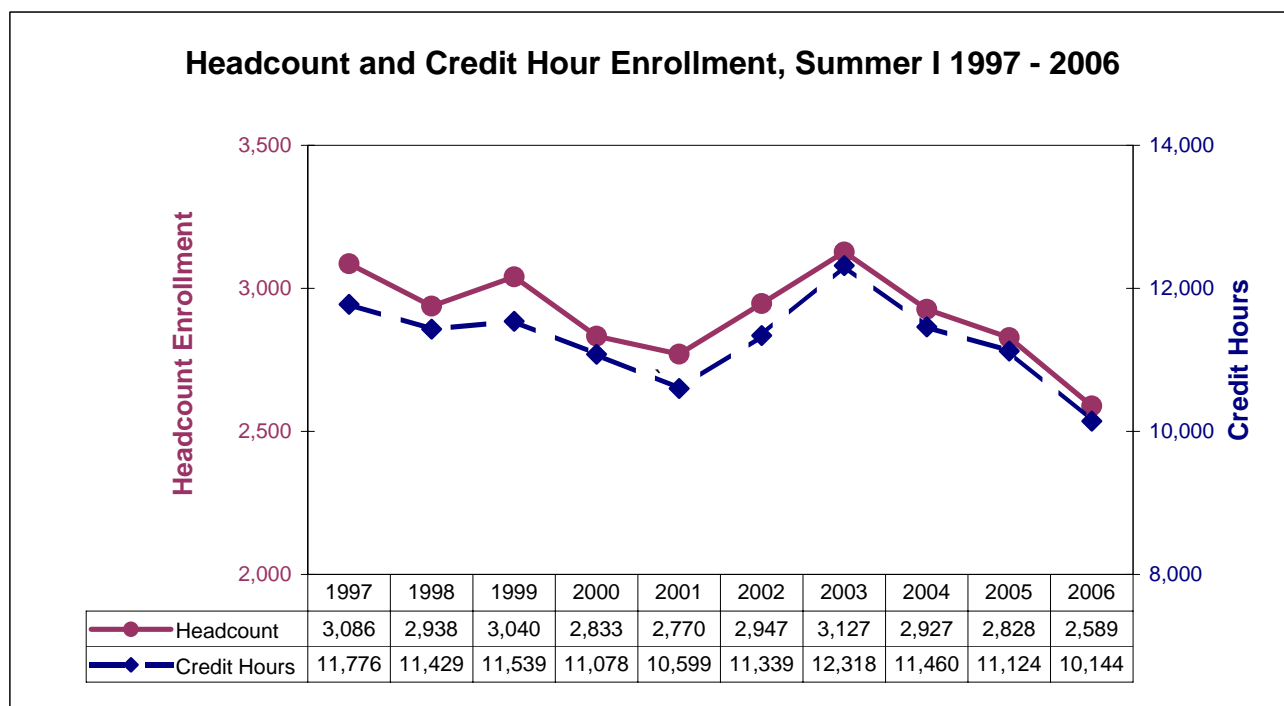
