- ⇒ Business, SPEA, and LAS all experienced some gains in headcount enrollment at the graduate level when compared to summer session last year.
- ⇒ Enrollments for the second summer session have reached a level not seen since the early 1980s.

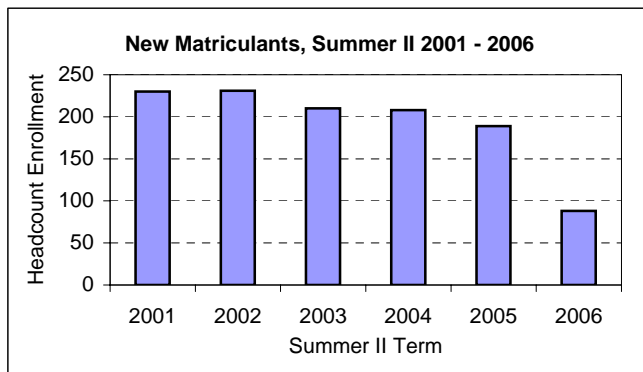
