Summer I 2007 Enrollment Highlights

- ⇒ IU South Bend headcount enrollments are down 6.2 percent compared to last year, but the declines were primarily part-time students and credit hours dipped only 3.4 percent.
- ⇒ School of Business and Economics, the Raclin School of the Arts, and graduate programs in SPEA and LAS experienced the largest increases in summer I enrollments (see page 2 for details).
- ⇒ IU South Bend continues to experience an increase in the number of Hispanic enrollments with an almost 13 percent increase compared to last first summer session.
