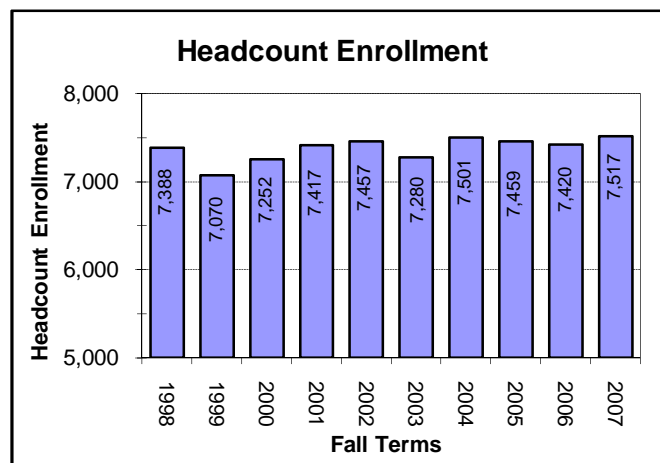
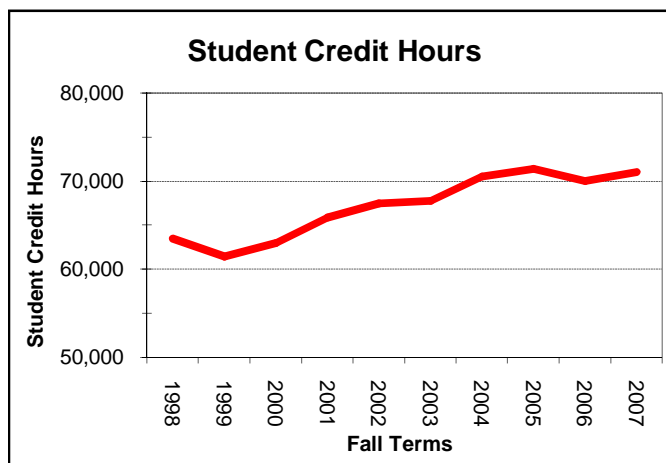

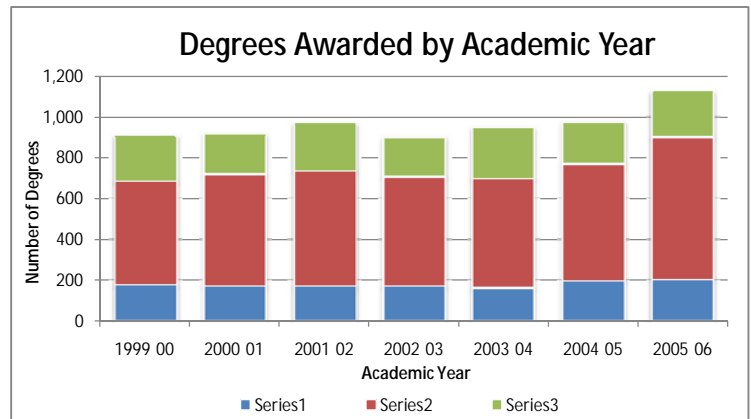

<sup>b</sup> This table summarizes the data submitted to IPEDS with the Graduation Rates Survey. The cohort is defined as full-time beginner (FTB), degree-seeking students who matriculated in either of the preceding summer sessions or in the fall, or students who began their coursework in high school and enrolled as traditional college students in the fall. These graduation rates combine all degree-seeking FTB students and provide the number of students who earned their degree within 150% of program length.
