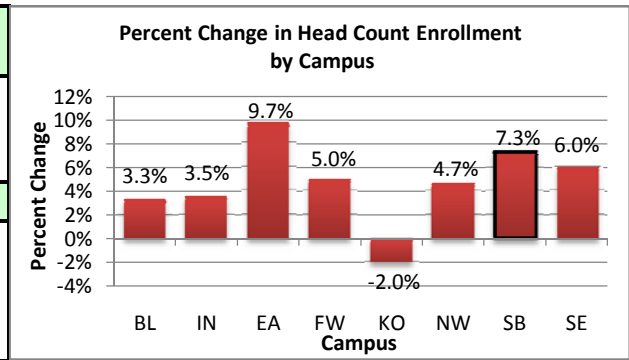
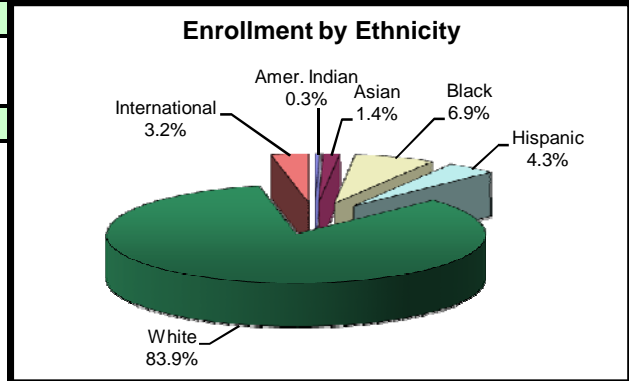

Spring 2009 Enrollment Highlights

- ⇒ Enrollments are up 7.3 percent over last year at 7,142 student, highest enrollment since 1993. The all-time highest enrollment record was set in 1993 with 7,348 students.
- ⇒ A total of 67,427 credit hours, an 8.1 percent increase compared to last spring, establishes a new record high for IU South Bend.
- ⇒ The freshmen class is 1,732 students, a 12 percent increase compared to last spring.

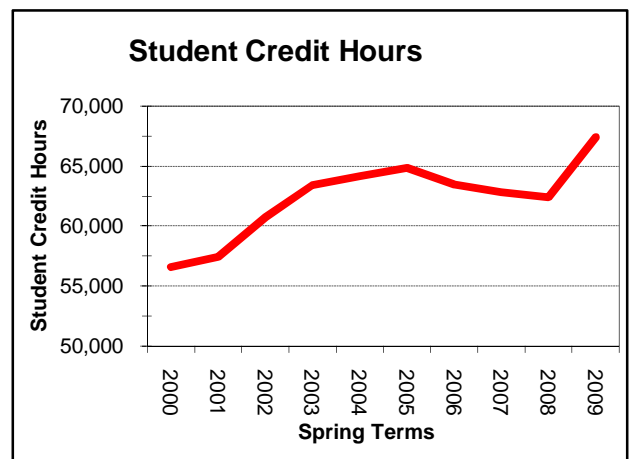
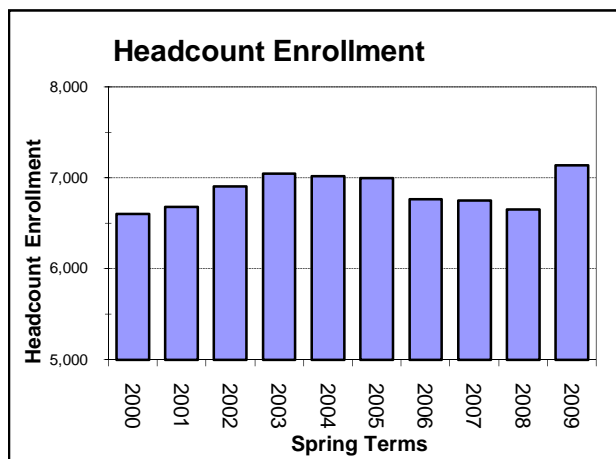
