### Summer II 2009 Enrollment Highlights

- ⇒ Overall, IU headcount and credit hours are up statewide.
- ⇒ IUSB headcount increased 9.8%, credit hours increased 7.6%, and full-time equivalents increased 6.3% compared to last year.
- ⇒ Hispanic enrollment increased 74%.
- ⇒ Progressive increases in enrollment by class level may indicate the further along students are the more likely they are to take summer classes to advance before the fall semester and decrease time to getting a degree.
