Single graduate non-business students must provide evidence in the (minimum) amount of \$23,043 to meet expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of Summer Session tuition. Students planning to attend Summer Session should add \$7,107 for graduate non-business tuition and fees. A married student must add \$6,000 for a spouse or other first dependent plus \$2,000 for each additional dependent. Please note that University sponsored Health and Accident Insurance is required for all international students and their dependents.
