Estimated Student Expenditures 2009-2010

1. IUSB Tuition and Fees
In-state Tuition: \$177.45/credit hour (new student out-of-state tuition=\$481.35/credit hour)
(Refer to www.iusb.edu/bursarb/ for anticipated change in tuition)
Activity Fee: \$28.55 fall/spring 1-6 credit hours/\$57.10 fall/spring more than 6 credit hours
Technology Fee: \$54.00 for 1-3 credit hours/ \$108.25 for 3.5-6 credit hours/\$162.40 for more than 6 credit hours
Lab Fee: \$59.00/lab course (H218, H219, H301, H302, R305, R306, R307)
Parking Fee: \$5.70/credit hour
2. Criminal History Background Check fee \$50.00 (estimate)
3. Textbooks \$1,200.00/1st year (estimate). This cost will be lower in the second year.
4. Clinic Fees
A) Instrument Kit \$998.00
Dental hygiene students purchase dental instruments and supplies for use in the pre-clinical and clinical classes. Kit payment is due August 15th to Patterson Dental. See enclosure. Anticipate replacement costs during the second year.
B) Equipment and Clinic Fee \$250.00/semester
This fee covers large and small equipment used by students during patient treatment. This fee is due at the beginning of each semester.
5. Safety Equipment/Personal Protective Equipment \$100.00/year (estimate)
Students purchase their own personal protective equipment (PPE) for use during pre-clinical and clinical courses work. PPE includes eyewear, gloves, and masks. Regulation eye protection includes glasses with solid side shields, goggles or chin-length face shields. During the first week of classes, students will have the opportunity to try the various types of PPE before making a purchase.
6. Uniforms \$125.00 (estimate)
Students wear scrubs covered by disposable gowns during patient treatment. Students must purchase two sets of scrubs and one lab coat. See enclosure for details. The cost of the disposable gowns will be covered by the fees charged for a class with labs/clinics (H218, H219, H301, H302, H305, H306, H307) The lab fee is estimated at \$48.00 per course
7. Hepatitis B Vaccination
Hepatitis B vaccination = \$150.00 - \$200.00 (estimate)
Arrangements for the vaccination can be made with the Indiana University South Bend Wellness Center or your family physician.
8. Licensure Exam Fees (estimates for 2008)

Board Clinic Fee	100.00

9. Professional Membership
Student American Dental Hygienists' Association \$90.00 (\$45 per year)
This membership provides two monthly professional journals, reduced fees to professional meetings, and eligibility for some dental hygiene scholarships.
