PROGRAM DESCRIPTION - Overview

Project LEAD (Leadership, Enrichment, Advancement, and Development) is designed to develop leadership skills and connect students within all aspects of the IU South Bend population, not just those involved in clubs and organizations.

Students who participate in **Project LEAD** will gain points by attending programs, joining student organizations, playing intramurals, holding leadership positions and much more on campus. At the end of each academic year students will receive recognition based on the number of points they achieved.

All programs included in **Project LEAD** will fit within one category: Leadership, Enrichment, Advancement or Development. Student who sign up to participate will receive regular email communication from the Student Life office letting them know which programs will count for points under each area.

Leadership

- Participate in a local philanthropy event
- Complete a Focus2 Career Assessment Inventory
- Attend a Career or Academic Majors Fair

Development

- Volunteer with a local community agency
- Attend a Campus Theme event
- Meet with Career Services to review Resume/Cover Letter
- Visit the Writing Center
