I received a Summer 2002 faculty research grant to complete research and begin the writing for a project on "The 1960s University in the Public Imagination." Using the time allowed by the grant, I was able to gather all the materials I needed at the Museum of Television and Radio in New York, at the New York Public Library, and in the archives of Teachers College at Columbia University. Based on this research, I wrote a talk entitled "Good-bye Mr. Chips and Welcome Back, Kotter: Media Images of the Sixties' Classroom," which I presented at the *Conference on College Composition and Communication*, the annual meeting in my field, on March 20, 2003. The paper was well-received, and I am currently working to revise that paper toward an article-length publication which I will submit to a journal in my field.
