Skyline Corporation Scholarship

PURPOSE, CRITERIA, INFORMATION

The Skyline Corporation Scholarship provides a current or entering student enrolled at IU South Bend with financial assistance in completing or pursuing a degree. The scholarship is awarded annually through the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee.

The award is open to current and entering undergraduate and graduate students.

Applicants must be admitted to or currently attending IU South Bend.

To assist the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee in determining the most qualified recipient, applicants may complete and submit the following as part of the attached scholarship application:

1. IU South Bend financial aid application
2. A needs analysis form such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
3. A personal statement regarding your academic goals and what you hope to accomplish with your education

Note: Failure to provide financial need information, a personal statement, and/or access to academic records does not disqualify an applicant from consideration for the scholarship.

The amount of the award varies depending on funds available, as determined by the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee and the IU Foundation. The Skyline Corporation Scholarship may be given in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships.
