



INDIANA UNIVERSITY SOUTH BEND ALUMNI HONORS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Thanks to the generous financial support of IU South Bend's network of 28,000 alumni, the IU South Bend Alumni Association Scholarship is again available to qualified area high school seniors. These scholarships are awarded each year through the IU South Bend Alumni Association Scholarship Selection Committee.

In providing this scholarship, the goal of our alumni is to assist students who are interested in enrolling in IU South Bend's Honors Program. In addition, we know that IU South Bend's alumni achieve great success as business, education, health care and community leaders. By assisting with their educational costs, we are investing in the future of Michiana.

These scholarships, worth \$4,000 each, will be awarded for the freshman year only. This amount covers tuition for most full-time students at IU South Bend. Students who successfully complete their freshman year in the Honors Program and fulfill the program's prerequisites will then be awarded the Honors Program Scholarship (presently worth \$1,400) for subsequent years.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be an undergraduate student, formally admitted to IU South Bend; and
- be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester the year the scholarship is received.

Considerations:

- Admission to the Honors Program is at the discretion of the Honors Program Director, Frank Fujita.
- have a combined math/reading SAT score of at least 1200 or an ACT score of at least 27;
- rank in the top 10 percent of their senior class;
- have a GPA of at least 3.5 on a college prep curriculum (based on a seven semester transcript);
- graduate from a public or private high school in northern Indiana or southern Michigan.

The number of awards available will vary depending on funds available as determined by the IU South Bend Alumni Association Scholarship Committee. Applications are available in the IU South Bend Alumni Office, 1700 Mishawaka Avenue, Administration Building 101. Completed applications must be returned to the IU South Bend Alumni Office, PO Box 7111, South Bend, IN 46634-7111. The deadline is April 1, 2009.
