



## INDIANA UNIVERSITY SOUTH BEND SUEÑO ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Indiana University South Bend Alumni Association Sueño Scholarship has been established to provide undergraduate and graduate students enrolling for the first time or returning to IU South Bend with financial assistance in completing or pursuing a degree. The scholarship(s) will be awarded annually through the IU South Bend Alumni Association Scholarship Selection Committee. Preference is given to Hispanic-Latino students, but the scholarship is open to qualifying students of all ethnic and cultural backgrounds.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be an undergraduate or graduate student, formally admitted to or currently attending IU South Bend; and,
- be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours per semester the year the scholarship is received or credited to the student's account.

Considerations:

- Minimum 2.0 GPA for undergraduates, 3.0 for graduate students
- Financial need (FAFSA **or** alternate needs analysis required)
- Completed activity sheet (provided)
- Personal statement (please submit a 300-500 word essay on "How I plan to use my college education to benefit my community")
- One letter of reference from a high school counselor, university faculty member or academic advisor, or a community leader not related to the applicant or someone who has known you for five or more years

The number and amount of awards available will vary depending on funds available as determined by the IU South Bend Alumni Association Scholarship Committee. This scholarship may be given in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships.
