



## INDIANA UNIVERSITY SOUTH BEND YODER OIL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Thanks to the generous financial support of Yoder Oil Company, the IU South Bend Alumni Association is pleased to offer this scholarship to qualified area high school seniors. It is awarded through the IU South Bend Alumni Association Scholarship Selection Committee.

In providing this scholarship, the goal is to assist students who are interested in enrolling in IU South Bend's Honors Program and in the School of Business and Economics.

This scholarship, worth \$4,000, will be awarded for the freshman year only. This amount covers tuition for most full-time students at IU South Bend. Students who successfully complete their freshman year in the Honors Program and fulfill the program's prerequisites will then be awarded the Honors Program Scholarship (presently worth \$1,400) for subsequent years.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be an undergraduate student, formally admitted to IU South Bend; and
- be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester the year the scholarship is received.

Considerations:

- Admission to the Honors Program is at the discretion of the Honors Program Director, Frank Fujita.
- have a combined math/reading SAT score of at least 1200 or an ACT score of at least 27;
- rank in the top 10 percent of their senior class;
- have a GPA of at least 3.5 on a college prep curriculum (based on a seven semester transcript);
- graduate from one of the following high schools: Bethany Christian Schools, Christian Center, Clinton Christian School, Community Baptist Christian School, Elkhart Christian Academy (formerly Elkhart Baptist Christian School), First Baptist Christian School, Granger Christian School, Harrison Christian School, Ironwood Christian School, Redeemer Community Christian School, Trinity School at Greenlawn, United Christian School or Woodlawn School;
- must intend to take or be taking business courses or following a business curriculum as set out by the School of Business & Economics; or be willing to be an intern at Yoder Oil during their time as a student at IU South Bend; or intend to participate in IU South Bend student organizations such as Campus Crusade for Christ or Campus Bible Fellowship; or demonstrate a high level of volunteer activity; and;
- be a resident of St. Joseph or Elkhart Counties.
