2009-10 Bloss-Halasi Family Scholarship

PURPOSE and INFORMATION

The Bloss-Halasi Family Scholarship provides financial support for at least three full-time current and entering undergraduate students at IU South Bend who show academic promise with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0/4.0. Recipients must be a citizen of the United States who displays financial need as determined by the FAFSA or its equivalent. The number, amount, and recipients will be awarded annually through the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee, in consultation with David and Jeanette Bloss. Recipients shall be known as “Bloss Scholars”.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- (a) Be admitted to IU South Bend or be a current undergraduate student.
- (b) Demonstrate an outstanding academic record by maintaining a 3.0/4.0 or above cumulative GPA
- (d) Demonstrate financial need via completion of a needs analysis form such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- (e) Be enrolled as a full-time student (12 credit hours each semester).
- (f) Be a citizen of the United States.

RENEWAL

The scholarship is renewable for up to four years. For renewal, applicants must maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average, remain as a full time student (12 credit hours/semester), and participate in campus leadership activities, as determined by the IUSB Scholarship Committee. Applicants must submit a new application and complete a new needs analysis form such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every year to be considered for renewal. The value of the award varies according to the availability of funds.

The application must be received by the Office of Student Scholarships by April 1 each year.
