IU South Bend, Ivy Tech College North Central, Scholarship

PURPOSE and INFORMATION

The IU South Bend, Ivy Tech College North Central, Scholarship, recognizes one outstanding student each year who graduated from the South Bend, Elkhart, or Warsaw campus of Ivy Tech State College and intends to complete a bachelor's degree at Indiana University South Bend. Applications are reviewed by the Ivy Tech Office of Student Scholarships and a recommendation is forwarded to the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee for approval.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- (a) Be formally admitted to IU South Bend in a degree-seeking, undergraduate program.
- (b) Successfully completed or is on track to complete an associate degree or technical certificate at Ivy Tech with a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
- (c) Is eligible to participate in the May graduation exercises preceding the fall semester in which the student intends to enroll at IU South Bend.
- (d) Demonstrated leadership and or service to the college or the community.

To assist the Ivy Tech Scholarship Committee in choosing the most qualified recipient, applicants must submit the following:

- (a) A completed scholarship application
- (b) A one-page essay describing how the scholarship will assist you in achieving your personal, academic, and professional career goals
- (c) Two letters of recommendation from non-relatives familiar with your academic abilities, one of which must be from an Ivy Tech faculty member
- (d) Documentation of voluntary service to the college or community

The award is valued at \$1,000 per year (\$500 each semester; fall and spring) for full time (12 credit hours per semester) enrollment. The award may be used for any educational expense.

RENEWAL

Students are eligible to reapply for the scholarship on an annual basis, providing they have a 3.0 GPA at IU South Bend, and meet the satisfactory academic progress standards. The maximum award amount a student may receive from this scholarship is \$2,000 (\$1,000 per year for two years).

Applications are available at the Ivy Tech Office of Student Scholarships and at the IU South Bend scholarship Web site www.iusb.edu/~scholar1. Completed applications must be submitted to the Ivy Tech Office of Student Scholarships by **April 1** each year.
