Charles W. Cole Scholarship

PURPOSE and INFORMATION

The Charles W. Cole Scholarship provides financial support for undergraduate IU South Bend students from St. Joseph County, Indiana, or adjacent Indiana counties, to complete a bachelor's degree at IU South Bend. Current undergraduates, incoming freshmen, and transfer students may apply. The scholarship is awarded annually by the IU South Bend scholarship committee.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

1. Rank below the top 10 percent of their graduating high school class.
2. Demonstrate financial need by completing a needs analysis form such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
3. Maintain a minimum 2.50 semester and cumulative GPA and satisfactory academic progress toward a degree at IU South Bend.

VALUE

Scholarship awards vary depending on financial need and the number of credit hours enrolled. Maximum annual awards are expected to be \$3,600 (\$1,800 per semester for full time [12+ credit hours] enrollment), \$2,600 (\$1,300 per semester for three quarter time [9 to 11 credit hours] enrollment), and \$1,800 (\$900 each semester for half time [6 to 8 credit hours] enrollment). Summer credit hours will be pro-rated as well.

Award amounts include a book stipend and may also be allocated to the following educational expenses that have not been paid by any other grant or scholarship: IU South Bend tuition, fees, and parking. Additional funds to pay child care expenses at the IU South Bend Child Development Center may be requested. Cole Scholarship recipients may apply for additional funds for summer school. Recipients are subject to the IU South Bend Financial Aid Withdrawal Policy. This means that all financial aid, including the Cole Scholarship, is recalculated under two circumstances: 1) if a recipient withdraws from a class or classes during the first week of classes; or 2) if a recipient withdraws from all classes during the first 60 percent of the semester. The recalculation of awards under either circumstance may require a repayment of funds to the Cole Scholarship account. Any required repayment must be completed before further scholarship funds are released.

RENEWAL

An annual scholarship application and a needs analysis form, such as the FAFSA, are required each year to renew the scholarship. Preference is given to renewal applicants. Recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress, which is defined as maintaining a minimum 2.5 semester and cumulative GPA and completion of at least 80 percent of enrolled courses. Failure to maintain satisfactory academic progress results in the loss of the Cole Scholarship for a minimum of one calendar year. An appeal to regain the scholarship may be made after the academic year is complete. Recipients are expected to enroll in continuous semesters for the fall and spring semester. However, recipients may make a written appeal for a leave of absence for up to one year, in the event of extenuating circumstances.
