## Donna B. Harlan Scholarship

### **PURPOSE and INFORMATION**

This scholarship honors the memory of IU South Bend librarian Donna B. Harlan, who served the university and its community with distinction from 1966 until her retirement in 1990. The Donna B. Harlan Scholarship provides financial support for IU South Bend undergraduate students from St. Joseph County, Indiana, or adjacent Indiana counties. The scholarship is awarded annually through the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee.

### **CRITERIA**

Applicants must:

- (a) Be formally admitted to IU South Bend as an undergraduate student.
- (b) Be of nontraditional age or returning adult student.
- (c) Be pursuing a bachelor's degree.
- (d) Demonstrate financial need via completion of a needs analysis form such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- (e) Preference is given to candidates who are working mothers employed outside the home and who have sole or shared parental responsibility for minor children.

Awards ordinarily are for \$500 to assist with the actual cost of tuition, fees, books, IU South Bend child care, and parking, which are not covered by other grants or scholarships. Amounts vary based on enrolled hours and the availability of funds.

### **RENEWAL**

To be considered for renewal, recipients must apply annually, continue to meet the above requirements, maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, and attend two of the four academic sessions per year.
