IU South Bend Leadership Award

PURPOSE and INFORMATION

IU South Bend Leadership Awards are awarded to encourage undergraduate student involvement in leadership activities at IU South Bend. The awards are given annually through the IU South Bend Scholarship Committee.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- (a) Be formally admitted to or currently attending IU South Bend.
- (b) Be enrolled in at least six credit hours as an undergraduate student for each semester that they receive the award.
- (c) Provide a full description of their proposed leadership activities and an approved plan of participation in the IU South Bend campus and student life activities.
- (d) Provide two letters of reference submitted directly to the Office of Student Scholarships. Letters must reference the Leadership Award.
- (e) Demonstrate financial need through completion of a needs analysis form, such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Each leadership award varies from \$500 to \$1,500 per academic year, depending on available funds.

RENEWAL

Awards are renewable up to eight regular academic semesters, or upon completion of the first bachelor's degree; whichever comes first. Renewal is based on an evaluation of demonstrated leadership activities, progress reports, and the recommendation of the relevant IU South Bend faculty or staff mentor.

RESPONSIBILITY

Recipients of the leadership award must develop and carry out a plan to take an active role in at least one IU South Bend campus or student life program. The approval of an IU South Bend faculty or staff mentor and regular progress reports are required.

Completed applications must be received by the Office of Student Scholarships by April 1 of each year.
