This position is to replace Dr. Doug McMillen for one year. The position is central to our program and essential for our certification by the American Chemical Association.

The search and Screen Committee consists of Gretchen Anderson (chair), William Feighery, Constance Fox, Matthew Marmorino, and Grace Muna

The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching C341 and C343 (Organic Chemistry I and Organic Chemistry II, respectively), C342 and C344 (Organic Chemistry Lab I and II), and discussion sections for freshman chemistry courses, C105 and C106. The total FTE will be 75% fall and spring semesters. The successful candidate will be responsible for a research program in organic chemistry or chemistry education. There will be no start-up funds provided for research, but the candidate will have access to an amply equipped laboratory and to the full range of instrumentation available in the department.

Screening of applications will begin on or shortly after February 18. Our target date for requesting authorization for on campus visits is February 20, with visits to be scheduled during the first two weeks of March. The target date for sending recommendations to hire is within one week of the last campus visit.
