**Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians
Employee Fee Assistance Program**

The Employee Fee Assistance program for employees of the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians was established to encourage employees to obtain their higher education degree while limiting college loan debt. The assistance program allows employees admitted to Indiana University South Bend as out-of-state residents the opportunity to attend at a discounted tuition rate while employed by the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians.

Criteria

The Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indian Employee Fee Assistance program is intended to promote the attainment of a four-year baccalaureate or graduate degree. To receive this award, students must:

- Be an admitted IU South Bend student with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA;
- Be an Employee of the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians;
- Provide a letter or email confirming employment by the band annually; and
- Enroll in a minimum of 6 credit hours during the fall and spring terms.

Award

The Employee Fee Assistance Program will provide out-of-state undergraduate students with a \$250 per credit hour award and graduate students with a \$300 per credit hour award. Students will continue to receive the award when they maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and remain an employee in good standing.

Awards will continue for eligible students until:

- A baccalaureate or graduate degree is obtained;
- Undergraduates reach 140 credit hours or graduate students reach 55 hours; or
- Twelve (12) fall and spring terms are funded.
