**Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians
Out-of-State Remission Application**

The Out-of-State Remission for members of the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians was established to encourage members to obtain their higher education degree while limiting college loan debt. The remission program allows members in good standing admitted to attend Indiana University South Bend the opportunity to attend at the current year’s in-state tuition rate when they reside in the following Southwest Michigan counties: Allegan, Berrien, Van Buren and Cass.

Criteria

The Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indian Out-of-State Remission program is intended to promote the attainment of a four-year baccalaureate or graduate degree. Awards will be no greater than the difference between the published in- and out-of state tuition rates. The following criteria will be followed when administering this award:

Students must do the following:

- Remain in good standing with the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians; (permanency of tribal status needs to be confirmed with the tribe)
- Submit a letter or email of eligibility from the tribe
- Maintain continuous enrollment during the fall and spring semesters; and
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards with the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships.

Students maintaining eligibility will receive the award until one of the following occurs:

- A baccalaureate or graduate diploma is obtained;
- Undergraduates reach 140 credit hours or graduate students reach 55 hours; or
- Twelve (12) fall and spring terms are funded.
